POST---OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS ELBOW ARTHROSCOPY

WOUND C	CARE					
		You may remove the Operative Dressing on PostOp Day #2.				
		Apply BandAids to the wounds. Change the BandAids daily. Please <u>do not use</u> Bacitracin or other ointments under the bandage.				
		Use Ice 34 times per day for the first 34 days, then as needed for pain relief.				
		A sling will be placed on your arm in the recovery room. You may remove it when at home and straighten your arm, but you should wear it in public placesfor a week or so for protection.				
		You may notice slight numbness, tingling, and swellingin the hand and fingers. Elevate the arm a and close your hand frequently to minimize this.				
		Rest with a pillow under your elbow.				
		You may shower on PostOp Day #2. Please cover the wound with plastic wrap and secure it to your skin with tape. You may remove the sling for showering. Gently pat the area dry. Do not soak the elbow in water. Do not go swimming in the pool or ocean until your sutures are removed and you are cleared by Dr. Gamradt.

		Avoid lifting heavy items with your operated arm until seen in theoffice for suture removal. Gentle Elbow Flexion / Extension (gentle bending and straightening) Hand / Wrist Range of Motion Exercises

	☐ You will be given two prescriptions for pain relief for you to use postoperatively:					
		 NAPROSYN, an antiinflammatory medication, is to be used twice a day with breakfast and dinner, for the first ten days after surgery. 				
		** IF YOU HAVE AN ULCER HISTORY OR DIFFICULTY USING ANTIINFLAMMATORIES OR ASPIRIN >> DO NOT USE				
		 VICODIN or PERCOCET, a strong narcotic, to be usedfor pain in addition to the Naprosyn. 				
		If you have any adverse effects with the medications, please call our office.				
		If you develop a Fever (101.5), Redness or Drainage from the surgical incision site, please call our office to arrange for an evaluation.				
FOLLOW	-UP					
		Please call the office to schedule a followup appointment for your suture removal, 1014 days post operatively.
