## POST---OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS – KNEE ARTHROSCOPY

		POSTOPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS - KINEE ARTHROSCOPY					
WOUND	CARE						
		You may remove the Operative Dressing on PostOp Day #2. THERE ARE WHITE TAPES DIRECTLY ON THE SKIN. THESE ARE STERISTRIPS—THESE SHOULD REMAIN ON.					
		Apply BandAids to the wounds. Please do not use Bacitracin or other ointments					
		under the bandage. An ACE wrap may be used to help control swelling. Do notwrap the ACE too tight.					
		Use Ice or the Cryocuff as often as possible for the first 34 days, then as needed for pain relief. Do not wrap the Ace too thickly or the cold may not penetrate.					
		You may shower on PostOp Day #2. Cover the incisions with plastic while you shower. Gently pat the area dry if it gets wet. <u>Do not soak</u> the knee in water. <u>Do not go swimming</u> in the pool or ocean until you are cleared by Dr. Gamradt to do so.					
		Crutches are provided for comfort. It is safe to put weight on theleg. When you feel comfortable walking without the crutches you may do so (on average 35 days).

		Keep your leg elevated with a pillow under your calf, NOT under the knee					
		Please perform the exercises on the attached Home Exercise Program 23 times daily:					
		☐ Towel Roll Under Heel					
		☐ Isometric Quadriceps Strengthening					
		☐ Straight Leg Raise					
DOST O		☐ Seated Active Assisted Range of Motion Exercises					
POSTOI		Enclosed are two prescriptions for you to use postoperatively:					
		<ul> <li>NAPROSYN, an antiinflammatory medication, is to be used twice a day with breakfast and dinner, for the first ten days after surgery.</li> </ul>					
		** IF YOU HAVE AN ULCER HISTORY OR DIFFICULTY USING ANTIINFLAMMATORIES OR ASPIRIN >> USE ONLY VICODIN					
		☐ VICODIN, a strong narcotic, is to be usedfor pain relief as needed.					
		If you have any adverse effects with the medications, please call our office.					
		If you develop a Fever (101.5), Redness or Drainage from the surgical incision site, please call our office to arrange for an evaluation.					
FOLLOW-	UP						
		Please call the office to schedule a followup appointment for your wound check, 710 days post operatively. Dr. Gamradt will prescribe physical therapy atthis time.
